Reply :

The original estimated number of food samples to be taken for testing in 2006 as shown in the 2006-07 Estimate was 63 000. For 2007, the Administration will enhance its food surveillance work, including taking 65 000 samples for testing under the food surveillance programme, as well as taking additional samples in response to food complaints and food incidents; and strengthen the existing food safety functions, including import control, veterinary input in the management of local slaughterhouses and risk communication capabilities.
