Reply:

Under the Hygiene Manager and Hygiene Supervisor (HS) Scheme launched in May 2005, the Department has provided free HS training courses for food handlers of licensed food premises and will continue to do so in 2007-08. The financial provision for the HS courses in 2007-08 is estimated to be \$0.7 million and the estimated number of food handlers who will attend the training is 6 000.
