In 2007-08, in addition to ad-hoc studies on topical issues of food safety and public health concern, the Centre for Food Safety will conduct seven major thematic risk assessment studies, topics of which include benzoates in prepackaged beverages, mercury in various fish species, microbiological quality of poached chicken, and trans fat in indigenous foods. There is no separate breakdown on the financial provision specially reserved for the thematic risk assessment studies.
