If so, what are the details? If not, what are the reasons?

Reply :

The Food Import and Export Section (FIES) and the Compliance and Investigation Unit (CIU) under the Centre for Food Safety are responsible for the control of import of food, including chilled pork and poultry, and inspections to farms exporting live food animals to Hong Kong and food processing plants in the Mainland and overseas.

Financial provisions of \$69 million and \$6.7 million have been earmarked in 2007-08 for the work of the FIES and CIU respectively. Separate breakdown on resources and manpower provided for inspection to slaughtering /processing plants of chilled pork and poultry is not readily available.
