Question:

Under this programme, provision for 2007-08 is \$85.10 million (13.7%) higher than the revised estimate for 2006-07. The work targets include conducting food surveillance at various points of the food chain, as well as investigating and managing food incidents. In 2006-07, the Administration failed to respond swiftly to Mainland food safety incidents. It was slow in source-tracing, investigation, and affirmation of food problems. The media identified the problems before the Administration and even tracked down the smuggling channel and proces. In this regard, please advise on how the increased provision will be allocated to carry out source-tracing as well as investigation and disclosure of food incidents in order to improve food surveillance and the related work as well as expedite the investigation process.

Reply:

A financial provision of \$37.2 million has been included in the 2007-08 Estimate for the creation of 75 posts and related departmental expenses, including Veterinary Officers, Field Officers, Scientific Officers, Health Inspectors and administrative support staff for enhancing food import control, strengthening veterinary input in the management of local slaughterhouses as well as enhancing food safety risk communication capabilities.
