Question:

Please give a breakdown by district of the number of complaints about water seepage on ceilings/walls of residential premises received by the Joint Office of the Buildings Department (BD) and the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department in 2005, 2006 and 2007. Please advise on the number of Nuisance Notices issued; the number of prosecutions instituted; the number of convictions; the amount of fines in general; the number of cases that required application of Nuisance Orders from the court to order abatement of the nuisances; the number of complaints referred to BD or Water Supplies Department for follow up action; the average processing time for each complaint case that was not referred to other departments; the number of cases for which the source of nuisance could not be identified; the annual expenditure involved in handling complaints; and the resources earmarked for handling these complaints in 2008-09.

Reply:

The breakdown by district of the number of water seepage complaints received by the Joint Office in 2005, 2006 and 2007 is set out at Annex. Up to end-2007, cumulatively, 835 Nuisance Notices were issued; 27 prosecutions were instituted; 17 convictions were recorded and nine Nuisance Orders were obtained. The amount of fines ranged from \$500 to \$2,500. The number of complaints referred to the Buildings Department and Water Supplies Department for follow up action is 487 and 377 respectively. In 370 cases, the source of seepage could not be identified. Information on the average processing time for complaint cases not referred to other departments is not available.

For the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department, the direct expenditure incurred by the Joint Office in 2005-06 and 2006-07 was \$3.1 million and \$14.8 million respectively. The estimated direct expenditure for 2007-08 is about \$17 million. The estimated expenditure for 2008-09 will be similar to that of 2007-08 and will be provided for from within the existing allocation.
