Question:

What are the specific plans for prevention of avian influenza in 2008-09? What is the financial provision for taking blood samples from poultry?

## Reply:

The control measures taken to prevent the introduction of avian influenza into Hong Kong include: poultry farm inspections and liaison with the Mainland authorities to ensure that requirements on animal health, quarantine and farm conditions are complied with; inspection of every consignment of imported poultry including verifying Animal Health Certificates; and collecting blood samples and cloacal swabs for laboratory testing of avian influenza H5.

A financial provision of \$9.4 million has been included in the 2008-09 Estimate for inspection and blood sampling at the border control point.
