## Reply:

In 2008-09, FEHD's estimated expenditure on public cleansing services will be \$1,752 million. In terms of manpower deployed, about 64% of street cleansing services is being provided by contractors. It is estimated that 5 390 workers will be employed by contractors in 2008-09 for providing public cleansing services, compared to 5 070 in 2007-08.
