The type and number of registered Mainland farms exporting live food animals to Hong Kong in 2009 is tabulated as follows-

Number of Registered Farms	91	296	77	5	61

In 2009, a total of 52 Mainland farms were inspected. Fifty farm inspections are planned for 2010. The breakdown of farms inspected in 2009 by type is tabulated as follows-

Number of Inspections	35	9	8

Farm inspections are carried out by inspection teams comprising veterinary officers, field officers and research officer. About \$5.8 million in 2009-10 and \$6.8 million in 2010-11 is estimated to be spent on farm inspections.
