- (a) the provision earmarked for improving the trading environment of public markets; and
- (b) the measures to be taken to improve the trading environment of public markets.

Reply:

In 2013-14, in addition to regular maintenance and daily management of markets, the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department will implement the following measures to improve the operating environment of public markets -

- 1. To carry out improvement works in six markets, including upgrading of fire services facilities, improvement of ventilation and lighting systems, and refurbishment of toilets. The estimated cost is \$31.05 million.
- 2. To continue to conduct market promotional activities, especially during traditional festival periods. The estimated cost is \$4 million.
- 3. To continue to identify suitable vacant market stalls for conversion into service trade, bakery and light refreshment stalls. No additional resources are required.
