Question:

The Department is planning to reduce by phases the number of litter containers on streets to facilitate the implementation of a waste charging scheme in the future. In this connection, please advise this Committee on the following:

- 1. the number of litter containers and recyclables collection bins (RBs) in each of the 18 districts in the territory in the past 3 years;
- 2. the number of prosecutions against littering-related behaviour in each of the past 3 years; and
- 3. whether there are any measures to prevent the abusive use of litter containers placed on streets and disposal of refuse into RBs; if yes, the details; if not, the reason(s).

Reply:

The reduction in the number of litter containers contributes to waste management under the policy purview of the Environment Bureau.

1. The number of litter containers (LCs) and RBs provided by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (the Department) in each of the 18 districts in the territory in the past 3 years is provided below –
