In 2015, a total of 4 samples of vegetables taken from the Cheung Sha Wan Vegetable Marketing Organization were found to have pesticide residues not meeting the relevant food safety standards. In 2016, a total of 4 samples of aquatic products taken from the Cheung Sha Wan Wholesale Food Market were found to have veterinary drug residues not meeting the relevant food safety standards. In 2017, no food sample from the fresh food wholesale markets was found not meeting food safety standards.
