Reply:

At present, the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (the Department) deploys about 318 health inspectors to 19 district environmental hygiene offices across the territory to handle various environmental hygiene issues including, inter alia, the inspection and regulatory control of licensed food premises. The Department will keep under review the service requirements and suitably deploy manpower and resources to meet relevant operational needs. Where the need arises, the Department will seek additional resources in accordance with the established mechanism. The Department does not keep separate statistics on the manpower and resources involved in the inspection of food premises.
