Reply:

1. We have not quantified the "savings" achieved by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (the Department) through outsourcing. The main reasons for outsourcing are to enhance flexibility in responding to changing service needs by the community as well as to enable the Department to focus on tasks which must be discharged by the Government, e.g. reviewing the regulatory arrangements and enforcement, etc.
