Reply:

The Food and Environmental Hygiene Department launched an administrative Notification Scheme in June 2014 for participation by private columbaria on a voluntary basis. The purpose of collecting the information is to facilitate consideration of applications for specified instruments (if any) by the Private Columbaria Licensing Board (PCLB) and to implement the Private Columbaria Ordinance (Cap. 630) and related work.

The PCLB will publish information on the applications for specified instruments received. By then, the public will know which private columbaria have applied for an exemption, a licence and the related temporary suspension of liability. Private columbaria which apply for exemption will have to provide information to prove their "datedness", i.e. that the columbaria commenced operation before 1 January 1990, which is one of the application requirements for exemption.

Information on the area of the columbarium premises was not collected in the Notification Scheme, and we do not have complete information on whether the columbaria concerned are still in operation. Relevant information collected in the Notification Scheme is as follows –
