#### Ouestion:

Please advise this Committee on:

- (1) the 10 public toilets with the highest usage in the past 3 years;
- (2) the 10 most heavily complained public toilets and the major items of complaints in the past 3 years in tabular form;
- (3) the number of public toilets that are installed with automatic sensor taps in the territory, with a breakdown of 18 districts in tabular form; and
- (4) the number of public toilets that are installed with automatic sensor flushing system (e.g. intelligent sensing or foot-operated flushing system) in the territory, with a breakdown of 18 districts in tabular form.

## Reply:

- (1) The 10 public toilets with the highest utilisation managed by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department is set out at **Annex I**.
- From 2017 to 2019, the Department received 2 913, 2 626 and 2 367 complaints against public toilet/bathhouse services respectively. The major items of complaints involved service and management. The Department is enhancing the functions of the Complaints Management Information System which include maintenance of statistics of complaints with a breakdown by public toilet, so as to strengthen the analysis of relevant complaints for monitoring service outcome and implementing improvement measures. It is expected that the functions will be fully implemented after trial in the third quarter of 2020.
- (3)&(4) The number of public toilets with automatic sensor taps and automatic sensor flushing system broken down by district is provided at **Annex II**.
