Question:

With regard to the enforcement against shop front extensions (SFE), please advise this Committee on:

- 1) the number of complaints received and prosecutions instituted by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department in each of the past 3 years, with a breakdown by year and the 18 districts in the territory;
- 2) the manpower and expenditure involved in the Department's actions against SFE in each of the past 3 years;
- 3) the number of fixed penalty notices issued in 2018-19, given the implementation of the fixed penalty system, and also the estimated manpower and expenditure for 2019-20; and
- 4) the initiatives of the Department in the coming 12 months to step up clamp down measures in areas within Wong Tai Sin District where the problem of SFE by individual shops is serious, including Yuk Wah Street and Sheung Fung Street in Tsz Wan Shan, and Ngau Chi Wan Village.

Reply:

- 1) The number of complaints received and prosecutions instituted against shop front extensions (SFE) by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department in each of the past 3 calendar years, with a breakdown by year and district, is provided at Annex I.
- 2) Taking enforcement actions against SFE is one of the duties of the Department's hawker control staff. Information on the manpower and expenditure involved in hawker control in each of the past 3 calendar years is provided at Annex II. Further breakdown of the manpower and expenditure on enforcement actions in this respect is not available.

- 3) In 2019, the Department issued a total of 7 626 Fixed Penalty Notices against SFE. As an additional measure for tackling the problem of SFE, the fixed penalty system is part of the Department's overall enforcement work. There is no breakdown of the manpower and expenditure involved for 2019-20.
- 4) The Department will take enforcement actions against SFE in the light of actual circumstances. For locations with serious problem of SFE in Wong Tai Sin District, the Department will keep the situation under review and take appropriate actions, including blitz operations and law enforcement, to maintain environmental hygiene.
