The expenditure incurred by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department for outsourced public cleansing services in 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 (revised estimate) is \$1,163.8 million, \$1,223.7 million, \$1,386.0 million, \$1,617.2 million and \$2,056.0 million respectively.

The total number of cleansing workers employed by the Department's public cleansing service contractors, the number of times contract enforcement action was taken against breach of contract provisions and the amount of monthly service charge deducted in the past 5 calendar years are provided as follows:
