- 2. please provide the details of pest control work, including: (a) the total expenditure; (b) the civil service staffing and staff cost; and (c) the total number of outsourced workers, in the past 3 years and in the coming year.
- 3. how many anti-rodent operations were conducted in designated target areas in the past 3 years and how effective was each operation?
