Food Related Dry Goods

The sale of the following is permitted –

- (a) Biscuit, bread and bakery products;
- (b) Cigarettes;
- (c) Dried grocery products, e.g. spices, seasoning, nuts, rice, etc.;
- (d) Dried and preserved foods;
- (e) Eggs;
- (f) Prepacked food and drinks, including canned food;
- (g) Sweets and confectionery etc.; and
- (h) Vermicelli and noodles.

Non-Food Related Dry Goods

The sales of the following items are permitted: -

- (a) Blinds;
- (b) Blankets and cotton quilts;
- (c) Bamboo wares and baskets;
- (d) Books and stationery;
- (e) Clothing, cloth/lace/silk;
- (f) Curios;
- (g) Cassettes and video tapes;
- (h) * Chinese herbs and medicines;
- (i) Electric appliances and electronic parts;
- (j) Fishing equipment and accessories;
- (k) Films and photos;
- (l) Gift items, souvenirs and ornaments;
- (m) Haberdashery, footwear and umbrella;
- (n) Household wares;
- (o) Jade, jewellery and watches;
- (p) Joss sticks and papers, shrines and worshipping tables;
- (q) Kitchen utensils;
- (r) Lighters;
- (s) Locks;
- (t) Mahjong sets;
- (u) Nylon/canvas bags/sacks, rope and string;
- (v) Paintings
- (w) Perfumes and cosmetics
- (x) Spectacles;
- (y) Toys; and
- (z) Wallets, handbags and leather goods.

(Note: Any of the above items may be deleted in certain markets if necessary)

* Regarding the definition of 'Chinese herbs and medicines', the Department will draw reference to Schedules 1 and 2 of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

Food Related Wet Goods

The sale of the following is permitted –

- (a) Vegetables;
- (b) Bean curd;
- (c) Bean sprout; and
- (d) Raw vegetarian food in wet state.

Non-Food Related Wet Goods

The sale of the following is permitted –

- (a) Fresh flowers;
- (b) Potted plants; and
- (c) Aquarium fish and their associated equipment.

Note : A tenant is allowed to operate either Service Trade or Tradesman.

Note : A tenant is allowed to operate either Service Trade or Tradesman.

Foods that may be sold and/or prepared for sale at a “Ready-to-eat Food” stall

- (I) Foods that may be prepared for individual sale at the stall (may sell one or more of the following food items, but cannot sell/mix together)
1. Popcorn
 2. Cotton Candy
 3. Non-Bottled Drinks (drinks in dispensing machines, drinks prepared by dilution and fresh fruit juice only)
 4. Leung Fan
 5. Cut Fruit
 6. Frozen Confections (frozen confections sold by scoop only)

Note 1: For items (I) 1 or 2, an approved popcorn machine or approved cotton candy machine must be equipped. Please browse the approved models at https://www.fehd.hksarg/english/howtoseries/agent_index.html;

Note 2: For items (I) 3, 4, 5 and 6, all are restricted foods. A tenant must comply with the requirements of a “Restricted Food Permit” when commencing the business. Additional equipment, such as refrigerator, grease trap, additional wash-up sink, etc., may be required. Please browse the details of the requirements of a “Restricted Food Permit” at <https://www.fehd.gov.hk/english/licensing/guide.html>;

- (II) Prepackaged foods obtained from licensed food factories or other lawful sources may be sold at the stall (no food preparation and handling at the stall is allowed).

Prepackaged Foods

1. Sushi
2. Sashimi
3. Rice Ball
4. Meat to be Eaten in Raw State
5. Oyster to be Eaten in Raw state
6. Milk and Milk Beverages
7. Salad
8. Frozen Confections (frozen confections in manufacturers’ cups and wrappers only)
9. Chinese or Western Dessert

Note 3: For items (II) 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 and 8, all are restricted foods. A tenant must comply with the requirements of a “Restricted Food Permit” when commencing the business. Additional equipment, such as refrigerator, grease trap, additional wash-up sink, etc., may be required. - (III) Non-prepackaged foods: Foods shall be obtained from licensed food factories or other lawful sources and kept at a safe temperature.
1. Vegetarian Wheat Gluten (Lo-Mei)
 2. Bread
 3. Cake
